**TYPE OF INCIDENT:** Motor vehicle accident with extrication and helicopter use

**LOCATION:** Intersection of Marsh Creek Rd. and Highway 4

**OWNER OR OCCUPANTS' NAME:** NA

**RESPONDING COMPANIES:** E52, E59, BC5, EMS8, AMR, CHP , CCSO, CALSTAR

**NUMBER OF FIREFIGHTERS:** eight (8)

**CONDITIONS ON ARRIVAL:** Three vehicle accident with E52 treating patients. CHP on scene prior to our arrival.

**ACTIONS TAKEN TO CONTROL INCIDENT:** Captain 52 established IC. BC5 arrived to find E52 crew setting up for extrication of one victim. All other patient in the vehicles were either non-injury or minor injury. BC5 established "Marsh Helispot". E59 arrived and assisted E52 with extrication and patient care. EMS8 coordinated the ambulance requests. CALSTAR landed and one patient was flown to JMMC-WC trauma center.

**DESCRIPTION OF DAMAGE:** Heavy damage to three vehicles involved
