Count 1) PC187(a)

COUNT 1 – MURDER

The undersigned states, on information and belief, that Mark Thomas, Defendant, did commit a Felony, a violation of PC187(a), Murder, committed as follows:

On or about December 14, 2019, in the County of Contra Costa, State of California, the crime of Murder in violation of PC187(a), a Felony, was committed in that MARK THOMAS did unlawfully, and with malice aforethought murder Rafael Rodriguez Lopez, a human being.

ENHANCEMENT 1

PC12022.53(d): Special Allegation-Personal And Intentional Discharge Of A Firearm, GBI
It is further alleged as to Count 1 that said defendant, MARK THOMAS personally and intentionally discharged a firearm, a shotgun, which caused great bodily injury and death to Rafael Rodriguez Lopez within the meaning of Penal Code Section 12022.53(d) also causing the above offense to become a serious felony pursuant to Penal Code section 1192.7(c)(8) and a violent felony within the meaning of Penal Code section 667.5(c)(8).


ENHANCEMENT 2

PC190.2(a)(17): Special Allegation-Felony Murder - Robbery
It is further alleged as to Count 1 that the murder of Rafael Rodriguez Lopez was committed by defendant, MARK THOMAS while the said defendant, MARK THOMAS was engaged in the attempted commission of the crime of robbery in violation of Penal Code Section 211 and 212.5, within the meaning of Penal Code Section 190.2(a)(17).

Complainant requests that the Defendant[s] be dealt with according to the law.
