The Enforcement Division of the Fair Political Practices Commission has received the enclosed complaint against you. It appears the complainant is alleging you have violated the Political Reform Act's<sup>1</sup> campaign disclosure provisions. At this time, we have not made any determination about the allegation(s) made in the complaint. The complainant will be informed within 14 days if we intend to:

- investigate the allegations of the complaint;
- refer the complaint to another governmental agency;
- take no action on the complaint because, on the basis of the information provided, the Commission does not appear to have jurisdiction to investigate; or
- take no action on the complaint because the allegations of the complaint do not warrant the Commission's further action.
